→ **Specifics for Football Game at Shea 10.9.2020**

- The Concession Stands will only be accepting credit cards (no cash). The iPads get temperamental at times, so be prepared.
- The menu will be limited, so students should eat before the game. Some mentioned there will only be prepackaged items available (chips, candy bars, etc.)
- Although this has not been clarified, we believe we will be sending students to concessions in groups rather than allowing them all to go at once during 3rd quarter. Don't forget your mask!
- Only 300 tickets were available for sale. 500 total in attendance including all players (football, cheer, poms and band).
- The Band Boosters will be paying for the Senior Tickets. Mr. Rigolini mentioned that the plan is that seniors will be recognized at 6:15. Trevor Corr has volunteered to take pictures, and we are hoping he will be given a field pass to be on the field.
- All other marching band students have 1 ticket available for \$5. Mr. Rigolini is selling the tickets in his office. Tickets will be available for purchase through the end of rehearsal on Thursday, Oct 8th. Any tickets not claimed will be open for sale to all marching band families.
- Pep band will not be in the stands during the game. The plan is for them to be inside the fence on the sidelines. They will each have a chair, and the chairs will be placed 6 feet from one another.

- We do not know how many field passes we will be allowed but, without props, etc., we do not need any parent volunteers to help push equipment on the field.
- Thanks to the Guessas family for donating gators for our drumline, and to Mr. Rigolini and Mr. Barker for providing black masks for the band. These will be distributed at the game on Friday.

→ Fundraising Updates

World's Finest Chocolate

- Fundraiser ends Friday Oct 9th. Most students have turned in their money or unsold boxes. We have raised enough funds to send the company a check for \$3,000. The remaining funds are ours to keep.
- Parent feedback – easy, supply on hand, sells itself, variety. The faculty and staff was very thankful for the note and free candy bar that was placed in their mailboxes. Staff responded by supporting the fundraiser and buying more bars. All in agreement to continue this fundraiser in future years.

- The Board and Staff worked to update the outdated Booster ByLaws. An email was sent (September 28, 2020) to notify parents of the new 2020 ByLaws, and requested that parents review the old and new bylaws. We also requested that parents respond with any questions, comments, or concerns. No responses were received.
- ByLaws were updated to fit the program of how a 501c3 should function. ByLaws supplement the rules already defined by the State of Colorado.
- Motion to approve proposed 2020 ByLaws approved by all in attendance. No objections.

- Current P&L was reviewed during the meeting.
- All families that currently have an account with an open debit or credit balance have been emailed. Those families that have not responded, will be sent an actual paper statement to try to get responses ASAP.

- A handful payments have been received on accounts that had an open debit balance.
- A handful of accounts that had an open credit have either been moved to the Bookkeeper or have been nicely donated to the band account. Thank you so much to the families who donated their credit balance to the band!
